from 9 units on Beacon St. (HEARTH) to

(Hebrew SeniorLife)....





...and by for-profits:  
153 units on Kent Street (Winn)





# BROOKLINE HAS 2 ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES

46 units at Epoch in Chestnut Hill + skilled nursing

117 units (including some affordable)  
at Goddard Housing

Locus Map



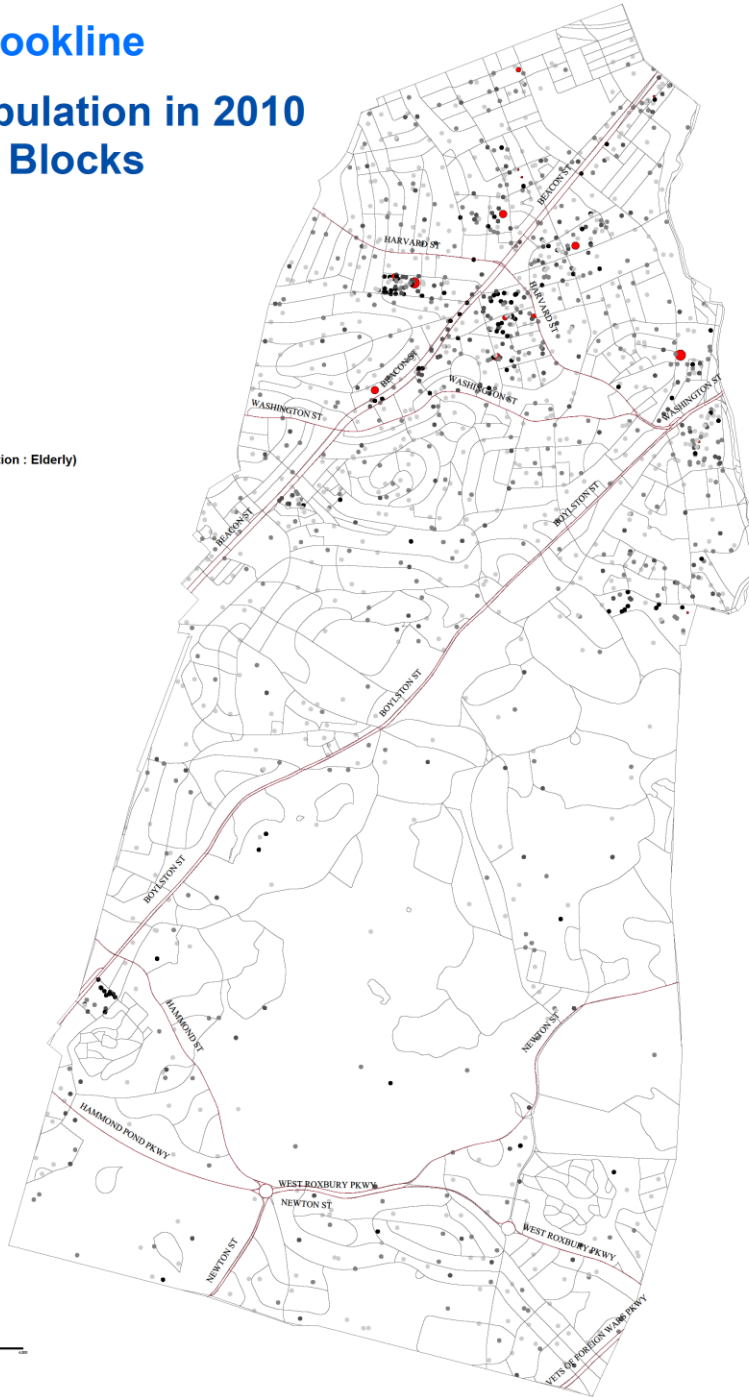
