What is a Traffic Crash?

- A traffic crash is an incident with ANY MODE(S) where:
 - two or more road users collide
 - a road user collides with personal/public property, causing damage and/or injury
- Typically police are not called unless:
 - A motor vehicle is involved
 - Property is damaged
 - Someone is injured
- If police are called, they may or may not:
 - Create a full report
 - Issue citation(s)



What is a Near Miss?

- A Near Miss is an incident where:
 - a crash nearly occurs (but doesn't)
 - no property is damaged
 - no injuries occur
- Examples:
 - Vehicle nearly hits pedestrian crossing street
 - One vehicle is nearly hit while another makes a turn
 - A bicycle nearly hits an obstruction on a shared use path

There is no mechanism for recording such events

What's the big deal?

- No record of an incident means
 - There may be a infrastructure deficiency that the Town is unaware of (e.g. faded crosswalk)
 - There may be behavioral problems that the conditions of a certain street/intersection allow or encourage (e.g. street design encourages speeding)

Mere seconds separate a Near Miss from a crash, so Town staff are missing a potentially helpful data point.

The point is to gather information!



What kind of information is helpful in a Near Miss report?

- Location
 - Street or address
 - At an intersection or midblock?
 - In a sidewalk, crosswalk, bike lane, travel lane, parking spot, etc.?
- Mode
 - What mode were you using?
 - What other modes were involved (directly or indirectly) in the incident?



What kind of information is helpful in a Near Miss report?

- Context
 - What were you doing?
 - Crossing the street
 - Biking in the bike lane
 - What was the other party doing?
 - Vehicle turning didn't yield
 - Scooter going through stop sign
 - Were there any other users whose actions played a role?
 - Bicyclist in bike lane swerves to avoid debris and nearly hits another bicyclist



What kind of information is helpful in a Near Miss report?

- Context/Relevant Environmental or Infrastructure Details
 - Inadequate lighting
 - Blind driveway
 - Confusing signage
 - Pothole
